



Recreation Fees and Passes on the Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forest



RECREATION FEES



Recreation fees vary by site across the Chattahoochee and Oconee National Forests. Payment is collected on site. In most cases, payment envelopes are the method by which fees are collected. After reading the fee information, visitors are required to place their fee into an envelope (provided), which is then deposited into a fee tube. Accepted payments are cash or check. Change is not available.

Please note that many areas are operated by a private concessionaire under special use permit from the U.S. Forest Service. There are four concession operations on the Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forest: *Chattahoochee Outdoor Adventures*, *Chattahoochee Management*, *The Cradle of Forestry Interpretive Association* and *Family Activity Enterprise*. In areas operated by these concessionaires, payment is made to the concessionaire.

RECREATION PASSES



Chattahoochee-Oconee Forest Annual Pass: \$25

Available at Forest Service offices in Gainesville, Blairsville, Chatsworth, Clayton, & Eatonton, Georgia

This pass will allow you to enjoy the many recreation opportunities on the Chattahoochee and the Oconee NF, without having to pay daily fees at each day use fee site. The Forest Annual Pass will be good for one year from the month of purchase. Those who have a Golden Age, Golden Access, Interagency Senior or Interagency Access Pass will receive a 50% discount off of the Forest Annual Pass. The Forest Annual Pass is not valid at concession sites.



Chattahoochee-Oconee OHV Annual Pass: \$50

Available at Forest Service offices in Gainesville, Blairsville, Chatsworth, Clayton, & Eatonton, Georgia


This Annual Pass entitles you to ride on any designated Off-Highway Vehicle Trail in the Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forests for 1 year, ending the last day of the month punched. You must have this Annual Pass in your possession when you are riding.



Chattahoochee Outdoor Adventures Annual Pass: (Concessionaire) \$50

Available by calling *Chattahoochee Outdoor Adventures* at 1-706-455-0342

This Annual Pass is valid at the following recreation areas for day use activities, only: Lake Winfield Scott, Morganton Point, DeSoto Falls, Lakewood Landing Boat Launch, Toccoa River Sandy Bottoms & Deep Hole. It is valid for 1 year from the date purchased.



Anna Ruby Falls Annual Pass: (The Cradle of Forestry Interpretive Association) \$20.00 per person (non-commercial vehicles) Includes 10% Off in Gift Shop

Second Pass Purchased at the Same Time: \$10.00 per person + 10% Off in Gift Shop

Available at the Anna Ruby Falls Visitor Center or by calling the Cradle of Forestry at 1-706-878-3574.

This Annual Pass is valid at Anna Ruby Falls, only. It is valid for 1 year from the date purchased.

Access Pass: \$0 Senior Pass (62+): \$10 Annual Pass: \$80

Available at Forest Service offices in Gainesville, Blairsville, Chatsworth, Clayton, & Eatonton, Georgia

These passes are honored nationwide at Forest Service, National Park Service, Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, and US Fish & Wildlife Service sites. The terms and conditions of each pass differ. Generally, the Senior and Access Pass will entitle the pass holder to a 50% discount on many expanded amenity fees, such as camping. On the Chattahoochee-Oconee National Forests, the Interagency Annual Pass is valid only at the Brasstown Bald Visitor Center. It will allow the pass holder to be admitted free of charge. INTERAGENCY PASSES - An Overview

The Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act (REA) was passed in the 2005 Consolidated Appropriations Act (PL 108-447) and signed into law by President Bush on December 8, 2004. The 10-year Act authorizes the Secretaries of the Interior and Agriculture to establish, modify, charge and collect recreation fees at Federal recreation lands and waters as provided for in the Act. In addition, REA established the development and implementation of national interagency recreation passes, named the "America the Beautiful -- National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Passes". These passes are known as the "Interagency Passes," for short. Visitors receive discounts at recreation areas depending on the type of fee charged and the type of pass they hold. Below, is an overview of the types of passes offered. **Please note that Golden Age and Golden Access Passports continue to be valid passes since they are good for a lifetime.**

1 INTERAGENCY SENIOR PASS - \$10

Valid for a lifetime; 62+

- Covers entrance to Fish and Wildlife Service Refuges and National Park sites that charge an entrance fee.
- Covers use of Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, and Forest Service sites that charge a standard amenity fee.
- The pass may provide a discount on some expanded amenity fees such as camping, highly developed boat launches and swimming sites, and guided tours.
- Valid for pass holder's lifetime.
- Per-vehicle Fee Areas: Admits the pass holder and any accompanying passengers in a private non-commercial vehicle.
- Per-person Fee Areas: Admits pass holder and up to 3 people (for a maximum of 4 people).



2 INTERAGENCY ACCESS PASS - FREE

Valid for a lifetime


- Covers entrance to Fish and Wildlife Service Refuges and National Park sites that charge an entrance fee.
- Covers use of Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, and Forest Service sites that charge a standard amenity fee.
- The pass may provide a discount on some expanded amenity fees such as camping, highly developed boat launches and swimming sites, and guided tours.
- Valid for pass holder's lifetime.
- Per-vehicle Fee Areas: Admits the pass holder and any accompanying passengers in a private non-commercial vehicle.
- Per-person Fee Areas: Admits pass holder and up to 3 people (for a maximum of 4 people).



3 INTERAGENCY ANNUAL PASS - \$80

Valid for one year

- Covers entrance to Fish and Wildlife Service Refuges and National Park sites that charge an entrance fee.
- Covers use of Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, and Forest Service sites that charge a standard amenity fee.
- Valid for 12 months from the month of purchase. Expires the last day of the month punched.
- Per-vehicle Fee Areas: Admits the pass holder and any accompanying passengers in a private non-commercial vehicle.
- Per-person Fee Areas: Admits pass holder and up to 3 people (for a maximum of 4 people).
