Pine Valley Fuels Corridor Environmental Assessment Decision

On August 12, 2003, Pine Valley District Ranger, Bevan Killpack, approved the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Pine Valley Fuels Corridor Project and signed a written decision to implement the Proposed Action. The project will create shaded fuelbreaks adjacent to the communities of Pine Valley and Central, Utah on approximately 516 acres of National Forest System Lands.

This decision is subject to appeal pursuant to 36 CFR 215.11. A written Notice of Appeal must be submitted within 45 days of publication of this notice in the Spectrum to:

If no appeal is received, implementation of this decision may occur on, but not before, 5 business days from the close of the appeal filing period. If an appeal is received, implementation may not occur for 15 days following the date of the appeal disposition.
