



National Mobile Food Service Contractors provide and operate mobile food service units to provide appetizing, well balanced hot meals, sack lunches, and supplemental food items at various field locations during wildland fire incidents and other types of activities throughout the contiguous western United States and Alaska. This includes all equipment, labor, materials, and supplies required to accomplish the full scope of work defined in the National Mobile Food Service Contract. The National Contract is available for use by the Forest Service and other cooperating Federal and State Agencies.

Occasionally, due to unusually high levels of wildland fire activity, it may become necessary to obtain the services of additional mobile food service units on a temporary basis when all of those units already under National Contract are committed to fire incidents or are otherwise unavailable. Additional mobile food service units are not added to the National Contract but instead are obtained through the use of an Emergency Equipment Rental Agreement (EERA) and only until such time that fire incident activity declines and National Contract units become available. Additional units obtained through the use of an EERA are available for use on a Call-When-Needed (CWN) basis. This means that the Government makes no guarantees, is not obligated to place orders for services under the EERA, and the Contractor may choose to accept or not accept any orders for services placed under the EERA. However, when services are provided under the EERA, these services shall be performed in accordance with the current National Mobile Food Service Contract specifications, terms, and conditions.

If you are just interested in providing your services on a CWN basis through an EERA, then you should communicate this desire in writing to the Contracting Officer, Melinda G. Draper, at the address shown below:

In your written request to be considered, you should include all information necessary to adequately describe your mobile food service unit, your capabilities, and your past performance history. You should also include meal pricing submitted in the prescribed format as shown in the following pages. A request to be considered for an Emergency Equipment Rental Agreement may be submitted at any time. However, please remember that we will not consider entering into an EERA for any additional CWN units until such time as all National Contract resources have been committed to fire incidents or are otherwise unavailable *and* an actual need for additional units has been established. We will not consider entering into any EERA in advance when there is not an actual need for additional units.

Dear Vendor:

This letter is a reminder that Contractors anticipating or currently doing business with Department of Agriculture (USDA) and potential vendors are required to register in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) System. This information in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) System must be updated yearly, even if there are no information changes.

As of October 1, 2003, vendors doing business with the Federal Government will be required to register in CCR before they can be awarded contracts, blanket agreements, blanket purchase agreements or basic ordering agreements.

The exceptions to the proposed registration requirement are: purchases that use the governmentwide commercial purchase card as the purchasing mechanism; classified contracts; contracts awarded in the conduct of emergency operations; contracts to support unusual or compelling needs; award to foreign vendors for work performed outside the United States if it is impractical to obtain CCR Information. A copy of the proposed rule can be found at <http://www.ccr.gov/>.

The CCR is designed to be a highly secure, single repository of vendor information. Vendors are able to register with identifying company information; including electronic funds transfer (EFT) data, and allows you to control the accuracy of your own business information. The data from your registration will be used for payment purposes, as well as by procurement for other business-related endeavors. A template containing the information necessary for registration can be found at <http://www.ccr.gov/handbook.cfm>. An excerpt of this included for your information. Only authorized government financial and procurement officials will be able to access the proprietary and sensitive data. Annual renewal/update by vendors is necessary to remain active.

The preferred method for completing registration is via the World Wide Web at <http://www.ccr.gov/>. A handbook and other information are available at that site, including information on how to obtain a DUNS number, which is required to begin the registration process. Once a vendor has registered in CCR a Trading Partner Identification Number (TPIN) is mailed to the individual identified by the vendor as the CCR point of contact. The TPIN is very important, as it is required for any changes to the registration.

MEMORANDUM FOR FEDERAL VENDORS

SUBJECT: Online Representations and Certifications Application (ORCA)

Dear Vendor,

Beginning January 1, 2005, the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) will require the use of the Online Representations and Certifications Application (ORCA) in Federal solicitations as a part of the proposal submission process. ORCA is a web-based system that centralizes and standardizes the collection, storage and viewing of many of the FAR required representations and certifications previously found in solicitations. With ORCA, you now have the ability to enter and maintain your representation and certification information, at your convenience, via the Internet, at <http://orca.bpn.gov>. In addition, rather than receiving and reviewing paper submissions, government contracting officials can access ORCA and review your information online as a part of the proposal evaluation process. You will no longer have to submit representations and certifications completed in ORCA with each offer. Instead, a solicitation will contain a single provision that will allow you to either certify that all of your representations and certifications in ORCA are current, complete and accurate as of the date of your signature, or list any changes.

To prepare for this requirement and to register in ORCA, you will need to have three items: an active Central Contractor Registration (CCR) record; a Marketing Partner Identification Number (MPIN) identified in that CCR record and a valid DUNS number. Your DUNS number and MPIN act as your company's ID and password into ORCA. (Visit www.ccr.gov for more information on creating and entering your MPIN). The basic information provided in your CCR record is used to pre-populate a number of fields in ORCA. Vendors are reminded to protect their MPIN from unauthorized use.

Once in ORCA you will be asked to review pertinent information pre-populated from CCR, provide a point of contact, and answer a questionnaire that contains up to 26 questions. The questionnaire is to help you gather information you need for the clauses. The questionnaire is not the official version. Be sure to read the provisions carefully.

The answers you provide are then automatically entered into the actual FAR provisions. You are required to review your information, as inserted, in context of the full-text provisions for accuracy; acknowledge three additional read-only provisions; and click a time/date stamp before final submission. You will need to review and/or update your ORCA record when necessary, but at least annually in order to maintain its active status.

FedBizOpps.gov Designated as GPE

“FedBizOpps”, managed by the General Services Administration (GSA), was designated by the Federal Acquisition Regulation (66 Fed. Reg 27407, May 16, 2001) as the Mandatory “Government wide point of entry (GPE)” effective October 1, 2001, for posting of Government business opportunities greater than \$25,000, including synopses of proposed contract actions, solicitations, and associated information, and subcontracting opportunity notices. During a transition period of October 1, 2001 through December 31, 2001, notices posted at FedBizOpps were forwarded to the previous GPE, the Commerce Business Daily (CBD). Effective January 1, 2002, the CBD was replaced by FedBizOpps as the official GPE and all Federal Procurement offices have been directed to utilize the FedBizOpps database. Effective January 4, 2002, the Department of Commerce ceased publication of the CBD through the U.S. Government Printing Office (GPO)

Note: Information on the Federal Business Opportunities website is FREE to the public. Some companies maintain similar looking Internet sites by re-posting information obtained from the FedBizOpps database. Most of these companies charge fees or sell monthly or yearly subscriptions for this service. Information that has been re-posted in this manner may contain errors and inaccuracies. Federal contracting professionals are responsible for the content of synopsis and solicitations submitted to FedBizOpps ONLY. The FedBizOpps staff does not make any changes or corrections to synopsis/solicitation content.
