IAT approved courses including: A-200 Mishap Review, A-205/305 Risk Management I & II, A-302 Personal Responsibility and Liability, A-303 Human Factors in Aviation, A-307 Aviation Policy and Regulations, and A-310 Overview of Crew Resource Management.

FHP-specific curriculum including: Accident and Incident Review, Flight Plans/Following and Dispatch Operations, Selecting the Right Aircraft, Aircraft Instrumentation, Meteorology and Flying Weather, Mountain and Canyon Flying, Airspace Coordination, Federal Aviation Regulations, and Operations.

NEW OPTIONAL American Red Cross CPR/First Aid offered in conjunction with AS2M. These courses are blended, include online lecture and written test to be completed prior to Classroom Skills and Training held Friday April 13th 2012.
