To increase operational safety and efficiency for fixed-wing and helicopter spray activities; combined with the on-line prerequisites, classroom curriculum is recommended by the AASC specifically for field personnel involved with air operations and safety, aviation contracting, project dispatching and coordination, block monitoring and aerial observation.

Course Subjects:

Address three broad topic areas 1) Aviation Safety and Management, 2) Project Personnel Responsibilities and, 3) Human Performance.
