

2004 CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

WIFDWC Outstanding Achievement Award (OAA)

Purpose of the Award: To recognize outstanding achievement in the field of forest pathology in Western North America. The award will recognize the individual that has contributed the most to the field of forest pathology in Western North America.

Nomination procedures: WIFDWC members may nominate another member for the award but they may not nominate themselves. An individual may only nominate one person per year. The award committee may decide not to name a recipient if suitable candidates are not nominated. Past OAA winners include Lew Roth and Duncan Morrison (2000), and Bob Gilbertson (2001).

If you would like to nominate someone for the WIFDWC Outstanding Achievement Award please submit the following information to one of the award committee members by March 15, 2004:

- A short letter of introduction naming the person you are nominating, their qualifications, educational background, work history etc., and any specific comments about their achievements in forest pathology,
- Your name and affiliation and any supporting people's name(s) and affiliation,
- If possible, copies of a few of the nominee's publications (a short list of significant publications is also acceptable).
