

Installing PC ArcView Solar Analyst

Download the file **solarext.exe** from <http://www.fs.fed.us/informs/download.php>


Administrator privileges on the PC are not required to install.

To install the program:

- Double-click on **solarext.exe**
- An install wizard will start. Click on **Setup**



- At the “Welcome” window, click on **Next**.
- At the “Software License Agreement” window, click on **Yes**
- Enter this license key on the next screen **Z0B8G6R2X1A7** (note this is alpha, num, alpha, num, etc.) and then click on **Next**.
- At the window shown below, click on browse and change the path to the install directory for PC ArcView. (Note: For Forest Service users this path is **c:\fsapps\esri\avgis_30\arcview.**)



- Click on **Next**.

- At the “Setup Type” window, select **Typical** (which is the default) and click on **Next**.
- On the window shown below, accept the defaults and click on **Next**.



- After the program is installed, click on **Finish**.

To uninstall the program, click on Start -> Settings -> Control Panel -> Add/Remove Programs. Select “The Solar Analyst” and click on the Change/Remove button.

User Manuals:

When Solar Analyst is installed, an on-line help system is installed. To start the help system, click on Help on any of the Solar Analyst Windows. For example, click on Solar -> Output Parameters. On the window that comes up, click on Help.
