

Overview of the Travel Plan 2006 Project Public Meeting

Public Notification

The public was notified of the meeting using a variety of methods:

- 1) A newsletter was mailed to 172 addresses.
- 2) Email messages were sent to 37 addresses.
- 3) A printed flyer was posted at 50 locations throughout northern Idaho.
- 4) A news release was sent to television, radio and newspapers throughout northern Idaho and the Spokane area. Information regarding the meeting was published in the Shoshone News-Press.
- 5) Project Team members shared information about the meeting during conversations with members of the public.


Meeting Attendance

A total of 54 attendees signed in for the meeting, which began at 6:30 p.m. This was a continuation of the proposal identification and screening process that began at the second public meeting, held at Canyon Elementary School in Cataldo on May 31, 2006. When signing in, attendees were given a copy of the steps for registering and screening proposed changes to the existing travel route system. Also available to them were copies of the Forest Service 2005 Travel Rule Federal Register Notice, the April and May 2006 newsletters that were sent to the public, an overview of the project based on the slideshow that was presented at the April 27 public meeting, and the five maps that comprise the routes available for consideration on the entire Coeur d'Alene River Ranger District (on compact disk). Additional process and timeline information was provided on wall posters.

Program Overview

The meeting started with a brief overview by the Project Team Leader, recapping the progress made in the last several weeks, and reviewing the steps for registering and screening proposed changes to the existing travel route system. After a few questions and answers, the attendees began registering and screening their proposed changes. A number of people indicated they were still working on their proposals, and would submit them at a later date.

At about 8:15 p.m., the attendees regrouped and the Team Leader thanked them for their attendance and participation, and announced that the next meeting was not yet scheduled but would likely be sometime in July. The meeting adjourned at approximately 8:30 p.m.
