Camp Ouachita Great Hall Available for Rent

HOT SPRINGS, AR – The Camp Ouachita Historic District Great Hall is available for use by the public for a fee of \$65.00 per day. The Great hall can accommodate groups up to 100 people. Currently amenities are limited. Chairs, tables and kitchen facilities are unavailable at this time.

Camp Ouachita, nestled in the Ouachita National Forest 40 minutes from Little Rock in Perry County, is a rare collection of native stone and cypress buildings on the shores of Lake Sylvia. Built between 1936 and 1941, the camp was designed and constructed for the Ouachita Girl Scout Council, which used the facility through December 31, 1979.

Camp Ouachita was formally included in the National Register of Historic Places on February 3, 1992. For several years, state and private partners have worked in partnership with U.S. Forest Service and the Central Arkansas Resource Conservation & Development Council to raise funds to restore the site. The restoration of the Great Hall completes the first phase of this project.
