



Dam Excitement

This area buzzed with activity during dam construction.

The water rose in 1928, flooding Bucks' creeks and meadows under the advancing reservoir.

In addition to electricity and irrigation, this source of power is also a source of play, providing beautiful settings for water recreation.

Ospreys and Bald Eagles, experts in open water fishing, replaced the meadow hunting raptors. Today, people and birds catch hatchery-raised fish including trout and Kokanee salmon.

The water drops 2,100 feet from the dam to this power house that, to this day, harnesses the water's energy.
