Annual Accomplishments Update (October 1, 2008-September 30, 2009)[†]:

The agreement between Northern Arizona University (NAU) and Pacific Southwest Research Station (PSW) has been completed. All sampling locations have been identified. We have identified data sources and obtained data for TEUI sites. The first year of field sampling is complete and we are in the process of measuring the tree cores collected during this field season.

Progress Report: October 1 to December 31, 2009

We have collected data on for 73 plots and will increase the sample size next year to capture more of the Basin. We are in the process of measuring the tree cores. Approximately 2/3 of the tree cores collected during the 2009 field season have been measured and cross-dated.
