### **Recreation Day Passes for Sale at Lolo Pass**

*Powell, ID* – Recreation day passes are now available for purchase at Lolo Pass on weekdays when the Visitor Center is closed. Day passes are \$5.00 and can be purchased by the front door of the Visitor Center. Passes must be paid for by cash or check. A pass is required for use of the area's trails. Season passes are \$20.00 and can only be purchased when the Visitor Center is open. Both day and season passes can also be purchased at Lolo Hot Springs, Brady's Sportsman's Surplus, Pipestone Mountaineering and The Trail Head.

The Lolo Pass Visitor Center is located on the Idaho-Montana state line along U.S. Highway 12. Winter hours of operation are Thursday through Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Pacific Standard Time.

Snowmobile and cross-country ski trails are being groomed weekly (Sat. & Sun.) depending upon snow conditions. Dogs are not allowed on the groomed trails. A snowshoe trail and sledding area are also available for use at Lolo Pass. Maps of area trails can be obtained at the Visitor Center. The Visitor Center also features an interpretive display room, gift shop, educational videos and local travel information.
