Abstract: This Draft Environmental Impact Statement documents the analysis of four alternatives (including a “no action” alternative) that was developed for the Forest-wide Travel Planning analysis. The Notice of Intent to prepare this document was published in the Federal Register on November 28, 2007. The Travel Planning project proposes to manage motorized and mechanized travel within the 1,827,380-acre Clearwater National Forest. The proposed activities include an amendment to the 1987 Clearwater Forest Plan.

A Final Environmental Impact Statement and a Record of Decision may be released following public review and comment on this Draft. Comments received in response to this solicitation, including names and addresses of those who comment, will be considered part of the public record on this proposed action and will be available for public inspection. Comments submitted anonymously will be accepted and considered; however, those who submit anonymous comments will not have standing to appeal the subsequent decision under 36 CFR Parts 215.
