## **NOTES**

### **Travel Codes**

Travel Code or "TravCode" defines the restrictions for non-winter vehicles. These are the vehicles that will be required to use designated routes shown on the Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM).

UND is a code used only in Alternative A, the existing condition. The starting point for Alternative A was the 2005 Travel Guide. This guide did not list all the system roads and trails on the forest and any that were not listed are shown with a TravCode of "UND" or undetermined status in Alternative A.

UND routes in Alternative A include the following:

Roads that have never been in the travel guides since best information is they are overgrown.

Roads discovered to be travellable with vehicles that should have been listed in the travel guide.

Roads on former DAW forest products lands in the upper north fork that are now part of the Clearwater NF.

Trails in storage (STO) status that have not been maintained in many years.

Routes suggested by the public during the travel planning process - those that passed basic screening for compatibility with the purpose and need for the Travel Plan and with Clearwater NF forest plan goals.

### **Vehicle Definitions**

VEH - means all motor vehicles over 50 inches wide measured at their widest point.

This category includes UTV's like the Yamaho Rhino, Kawasaki Mule, and similar vehicles regardless of width since these vehicles do not meet the definition of ATV shown below.

MOT - means all two-wheel notor vehicles like motorcycles, trail bikes, dirt bikes etc.

ATV - means all motor vehicles with three or more wheels or with tracks that are less than 50 inches wide measured at their widest point, with a saddle-style seat that is straddled by the operator and steered with handlebars. Any towed trailer must also meet the 50 inch width limit measured at its widest point. UTV's do not meet the definition of an ATV and cannot be used except where VEH, defined above are permitted.
