

# *Over-Snow Vehicle Codes and Definition*

## *Clearwater NF Travel Plan*

*SnoCodes explain reason and season for OverSnow vehicle restrictions.*

<i>SnoCode</i>	<i>Restricted Period</i>	<i>Explanation</i>
HUNT	SEE MAP	Oversnow vehicles restricted during big game hunting season. For Alts B, C and D applies to roads covered by forest-wide area restriction from 10/1-11/15. For Alt A applies to any restriction that covered hunting season but not winter.
AREA	SEE MAP	Oversnow vehicles restricted by areas - see map of restricted areas and dates. Used on Trails only
YR-WRG	YRLONG	Oversnow vehicles restricted Yearlong - Winter Range
YR-SKI	YRLONG	Oversnow vehicles restricted Yearlong - Ski Trails
YR-FAC	YRLONG	Oversnow vehicles restricted Yearlong - Facility
YR-SPECIAL	YRLONG	Oversnow vehicles restricted Yearlong - See individual route for info
NR	0	Oversnow vehicles Not Restricted. Existing Condition Alt A only.
WINTER	VARIOUS	Any oversnow vehicle restriction covering the Winter season. Alt A only
NCJ	NCJ	Route Not under Clearwater NF Jurisdiction

### *DEFINITION - Over Snow Vehicle*

Over-snow vehicles include any track driven motor vehicle designed exclusively for over-snow travel and operated entirely on snow. Examples include snowmobiles, Thiokols, Tucker Sno-Cats and similar vehicles.

Other track driven vehicles like tracked ATV's or ATV's fitted with removable tracks are generally considered summer vehicles and are governed by restrictions on the Motor Vehicle Use Map. They are considered over-snow vehicles only when operated entirely on snow and after November 15th.

Over-snow vehicles are not restricted to just designated routes - they can travel cross country over the snow in winter. They may be restricted on certain routes or in certain areas as noted above.
