

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS  
CLEARWATER NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest System Road 250 (Pierce-Superior Road), within the Clearwater National Forest, from July 16, 2010 until rescinded.

1. Using Motorized Vehicles towing any trailer. 36 CFR 261.54 (a).
2. Being on the road. 36 CFR 261.54(e).

**Described Area:**

The following restriction applies to any use by **Motorized Vehicles Towing Any Trailer** of the following National Forest System Road segments:

**Road 250 (Pierce-Superior Road):** From the Junction of Road 250 and Road 255 at Kelly Forks Work Center to mile post 55 near Fix Creek. [T39N, R10E, S18 to T40N, R10E, S16 Boise Meridian]. From mile post 61 near Lick Creek to mile post 57 near Hidden Creek. [T40N, R11E, S6 to T40N, R10E, S3 Boise Meridian].

The following restriction applies to **Being on the Road** of the following National Forest System Road segment:

**Road 250 (Pierce-Superior Road):** From mile post 55 near Fix Creek to mile post 57 near Hidden Creek. [T40N, R10E, S16 to T40N, R10E, S3 Boise Meridian].

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited use.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Forest Service administrative traffic.
4. Contractor and their personnel

The above restrictions are necessary for PUBLIC SAFETY. The restrictions are necessary because of bridge installation projects at the Fix Creek and Hidden Creek crossings. This portion of the Pierce-Superior Road 250 is narrow with no turn around available to vehicles towing trailers.
