

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS
CLEARWATER NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of National Forest System Road 5118 (North Fork Mud Creek Road), within the Clearwater National Forest, from September 7th, 2010 until rescinded.

1. Using Motorized Vehicles. 36 CFR 261.54 (a)

Described Area:

This restriction applies to any use by motorized vehicles of the following National Forest System Road:

Road 5118 (North Fork Mud Creek Road): From the junction of the Mud Creek Road 518 to the junction of the Buckner Creek Road 5051.

[T34N, R06E, S19 to T34N, R06E, S20 Boise Meridian].

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited use.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Forest Service administrative traffic.
4. Contractor and their personnel

The above restrictions are necessary for PUBLIC SAFETY. The restriction is necessary because of a FISH PASSAGE culvert installation projects at the Mud Creek crossings of the North Fork Mud Creek Road 5118 and the Kamiah-Pierce Road 100. To facilitate safe operation of excavation equipment and dump trucks on the road.
