

**ORDER NO. 11-D3-12**

**NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS & TRAILS**  
**CLEARWATER NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on the following trails as described below, within the North Fork Ranger District of the Clearwater National Forest, from date of signing until rescinded

1. Being on the trail. 36 CFR 261.55(a)

This restriction applies to any use on the following National Forest System Trails:

**Black Mountain Trail 396:** From the junction of Road 247 near Canyon Work Center to junction of the Black Lake Trail 685[T40N, R07E, S04 to T41N, R07E, S23, Boise Meridian].

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Forest Service administrative traffic.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

The above restrictions are necessary for **PUBLIC SAFETY** due to **Wildfire Fire Activity** in vicinity.

Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).
