

NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS
CLEARWATER NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on designated portions of Forest Development Road 247 (Beaver-Northfork Road), within the Clearwater National Forest, from March 24, 2011 until rescinded.

1. Using any motorized vehicles. 36 CFR 261.54 (a)

Described Area:

This restriction applies to motorized vehicles on Forest Development Road 247(Beaver-North Fork Road) from Bingo-Butte Road 699 [T39N R6E S5] to Twin Creek [T40N R7E S2].

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited use.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Forest Service administrative traffic.
4. Dale Barger and Barger Logging employees associated with the slide removal at Twin Creek.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

The above restrictions are necessary for public safety because of narrow roads and heavy equipment traffic.
