## **South Dakota Hunters Reminded to Get Their Travel Maps**

Camp Crook, SD...With the start of rifle deer season, hunters and other users of the Custer National Forest are encouraged to pick up their free copies of the travel map. The map, officially called the Motor Vehicle Use Map (MVUM), indicates which roads and trails are available to the public for motorized use.

The travel map is available at the Sioux Ranger District in Camp Crook and at area gas stations. Copies are also available in Billings at the Supervisor's Office at 1310 Main Street.

While out on the forest, anyone who observes poaching is encouraged to use the South Dakota Turn In Poachers (TIPs) website (<http://www.sdgfp.info/Wildlife/TIPS>) or toll-free phone number (1-888-OVERBAG). Anyone can report violations online or on the phone, and you can keep your report anonymous.
