Ranger District Hosts Tour of the Brush Creek Fire Area

The Tally Lake Ranger District of the Flathead National Forest is offering a guided tour of the Brush Creek Fire Wednesday, November 7. This is an opportunity to see what happened in the fire area, get a closer look at fire effects and recovery and a chance to visit with district employees about ongoing rehabilitation work and potential future management plans for the area. This summer, the Brush Creek Fire, located about 20 miles west of Whitefish, burned about 30,000 acres.

The tour is scheduled from 1:00pm to 5:00pm. Transportation will be provided. To reserve a seat for the tour, call the Tally Lake Ranger District Office, 406/863-5400 between the hours of 8am and 4:30pm. Interested participants need to sign up for the tour by 4:30pm on Monday, November 5. Be prepared for “rain or shine”. Wear appropriate clothing, footwear; bring water, and binoculars, if you wish. Hiking is not required although there are stops to get out for short walks.
