## Durnam Meadows Fire Contained

The Durnam Meadows fire, discovered September 11 on the Bozeman Ranger District is 100% contained today. It was burning in the Lee Metcalf Wilderness, Spanish Peaks Unit approximately 18 miles south of Gallatin Gateway and 5 miles north and east of Big Sky Meadow Village.

The 3 acre fire was human caused and is being investigated. The fire burned in the vicinity of the Asbestos Mine Trail (#80). The Forest Service is requesting information from anyone in the area on September 11 who may have seen others on or near this trail or saw vehicles parked at the Asbestos Mine Trailhead or the Durnam Meadow Trailhead to call (406) 587-6701.

“Please remember that stage 1 fire restrictions are in affect for portions of the Gallatin National Forest,” said Marna Daley, Gallatin National Forest Public Affairs Officer. “Stage 1 restrictions apply to all areas of the Forest outside of the Lee Metcalf and Absaroka-Beartooth Wilderness Areas and the Cooke City area.”
