Durnham Fire Discovered on Bozeman Ranger District

The Durnham Fire was discovered today on the Bozeman Ranger District. It is burning in the Lee Metcalf Wilderness, Spanish Peaks Unit approximately 18 miles south of Gallatin Gateway and 5 miles north and east of Big Sky Meadow Village.

The 2 acre fire was reported from people at Moose Meadows. It is burning primarily in grass with some timber. There are 10 firefighters and one helicopter on scene.

“The fire is burning close to a ridge top,” said Marna Daley, Gallatin National Forest Public Affairs Officer. “A cold front is expected to move into the area tomorrow bringing strong and gusty winds.”
