

Guided Short Hike to Red Canyon Fault

Come join Gallatin National Forest Guide Holly Pinson, on a guided hike to the Red Canyon Fault Scarp. She will take you to one of the faults that dropped during the 1959 Hebgen Lake Earthquake. The hike will cover 1 to 2 miles (round trip) of moderate terrain north of West Yellowstone.

Date: Wednesday, July 18, 2007.

Time: 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

Location: Meet at the Red Canyon Trailhead

Directions: The Red Canyon Trailhead is located 12 miles northwest of West Yellowstone, MT. Drive north on Hwy 191 8 miles and turn left on to Hwy 287. Drive west on Hwy 287 for 4 miles. The Red Canyon road #681 is located on the north side of the highway. Follow the gravel road 3 miles to the end.

Pack your lunch, water, binoculars, wear hiking boots, and appropriate clothing..
