## **Hyalite Canyon Continues Sliding onto Hyalite Road**

Bozeman, MT... Hyalite Canyon continues to slide in areas onto Hyalite Road. The Forest Service advises people using the area to drive slowly and cautiously as areas can slide without notice.

“The recent moisture continues to soften hill sides and road cuts making them weak,” said Marna Daley, Gallatin National Forest Public Affairs Officer. “People can expect rocks and debris on the road throughout June so please drive slowly.”

The Forest is installing concrete retainers in the area that slid last week, one mile above the first fishing access. The retainers will help hold debris off the road as it continues to move. Hyalite road is open although people driving the road can expect up to 20 minute delays while construction equipment is working in the area.

Most of the Forest is experiencing wet and muddy road and trail conditions making travel hazardous. For information on current road and trail conditions please contact the Bozeman Ranger District, (406) 522-2520.
