Iron Mountain Road Closed Temporarily for Hazard Tree Removal Work

The Iron Mountain Road (#482), located south of Big Timber, Montana will be closed temporarily beginning September 26 at 12:01 a.m. The closure, beginning at the Gallatin National Forest Boundary and extending to the end of the road, will be in affect while heavy equipment is working on or near the road to remove hazard trees burned during the Derby Fire. This work is part of the Iron Mountain Roadside Hazard Tree Removal Project.

People who have reserved the Deer Creek Cabin may be issued a temporary permit to access the Placer Gulch Trail #256 leading to the cabin by the Big Timber Ranger District.
