

**LEWIS AND CLARK NATIONAL FOREST
LEWIS AND CLARK NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL INTERPRETIVE CENTER
FOREST SUPERVISOR'S ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, 261.50(a) and (b), the following restrictions are in effect on the Lewis and Clark National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, become effective when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

36 CFR 261.55(b) – Forest Development Trails: Using any type of vehicle prohibited by this order. It is unlawful to operate any “vehicle” upon any trail within the boundaries of lands administered as part of the Lewis and Clark Interpretive Center (see attached map). For the purposes of this order, a “vehicle” is defined as “any device in, upon or by which any person or property is or may be transported, including, but not limited to, bicycles, skateboards and other wheeled devices.”

36 CFR 261.56 – Use of vehicles off National Forest System Roads: As provided by this order, it is prohibited to possess or use a vehicle off National Forest System Roads within the boundaries of lands administered as part of the Lewis and Clark Interpretive Center (see attached map).

36 CFR 261.58 – Occupancy and Use: As provided by this order, the following are prohibited within the boundaries of lands administered as part of the Lewis and Clark Interpretive Center (see attached map):

1. Camping. 261.58(e)
2. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. 261.58(g)

36 CFR 261.52 – Fire: As provided by this order, the following are prohibited with the boundaries of lands administered as part of the Lewis and Clark Interpretive Center (see attached map):

1. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. 261.52(a)
2. Using an explosive. 261.52(b)
3. Possessing, discharging or using any kind of firework or other pyrotechnic device. 261.52(f)

Exemptions: Pursuant to Title 36 CFR, 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this order:

1. Persons operating bicycles or skateboards on Trail #807, the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks Access Trail (see attached map.)
2. Persons operating bicycles or skateboards on Trail #808, the River’s Edge Trail (see attached map)
3. Persons operating bicycles on pavement within the designated Interpretive Center Parking area (see attached map).
4. Licensed operators of street legal, motorized vehicles within the designated Interpretive Center Parking area (see attached map).
5. Any person with a permit authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
6. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

Penalty: Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. (16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559 and 18 USC 3571).
