NANCY HALL NAMED INTERIUM DEPUTY FOREST SUPERVISOR

Nancy Hall will serve as the acting Deputy Forest Supervisor for the Lewis and Clark National Forest for the next several months. She is temporarily replacing Allen Rowley, who is serving as a Forest Service liaison in Senator Conrad Burns' office in Washington, D.C.

A 28-year Forest Service veteran, Hall comes to the forest from Jackson Hole, Wyoming, where she serves as the district ranger on the Jackson Ranger District for the Bridger-Teton National Forest. Prior to her appointment in Wyoming, Hall held administrative positions on the Arapaho-Roosevelt National Forest (Colorado), the Black Hills National Forest (South Dakota), and the Superior National Forest (Minnesota). She also served in the Eastern Regional Office in Milwaukee.

"I am deeply honored by the confidence the Forest Service has placed in me by providing this opportunity to serve in a leadership role on the Lewis and Clark National Forest. I am aware of the responsibilities this position holds and I'm eager to get to work by working with everyone," said Hall. "Building on what I call the four 'C's', communication, collaboration, cooperation and commitment, I hope to support and assist the forest staff in managing these vast and richly historic natural resources for today and for generations to come," she concluded.
