## FIRE RESTRICTIONS RESCINDED FOR ROCKY MOUNTAIN RANGER DISTRICT

Forest Service officials report that trail and area closures related to the Nanny Creek Wildland Fire Use (WFU) event have been rescinded. Also revoked are the temporary trail closures in the vicinity of the Cigarette Rock Fire incident on the Rocky Mountain Ranger District, Lewis and Clark National Forest.

Rocky Mountain District Ranger Mike Munoz stressed that while trail closures are now open, forest visitors should be extremely alert to the danger of falling snags in all areas of fire activity.
