


ANT PARK FIRE AREA – SPECIAL TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS

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THE ANT PARK WILDFIRE OF 2003 BURNED 2,150 ACRES IN THE SPUR PARK AND ANT PARK AREAS. SEVERAL CONSTRUCTED FIRELINES AND MOTORIZED VEHICLE ROUTES WERE CREATED TO FACILITATE FIRE SUPPRESSION ACTIVITIES. PUBLIC MOTORIZED USE OF THESE NEWLY ESTABLISHED ROUTES IS PROHIBITED TO PROTECT WATER AND SOIL RESOURCES AND TO MAINTAIN HABITAT SECURITY FOR BIG GAME. ALL ROUTES WITHIN THE TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREA THAT WERE OPEN TO PUBLIC USE PRIOR TO THE FIRE ARE STILL OPEN FOR PUBLIC MOTORIZED TRAVEL DURING SPECIFIC TIME PERIODS AS SHOWN ON THE ATTACHED MAP.

OPEN ROUTES ARE MARKED WITH BROWN “DESIGNATED ROUTE” SIGNS. ALL UNSIGNED ROUTES WITHIN THE DESIGNATED TRAVEL RESTRICTED AREA ARE CLOSED TO MOTORIZED USE.

VIOLATIONS OF TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS ARE SUBJECT TO FINES AND OTHER PENALTIES AS PROVIDED BY FEDERAL LAW. QUESTIONS REGARDING THESE TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS SHOULD BE DIRECTED TO ANY OF THE U.S. FOREST SERVICE OFFICES ON THE LEWIS AND CLARK NATIONAL FOREST AT WHITE SULPHUR SPRINGS, NEIHART, HARLOWTON, STANFORD, OR GREAT FALLS.
