LITTLE BELT, CASTLE, NORTH HALF CRAZY MOUNTAINS TRAVEL MANAGEMENT PLAN RECORD OF DECISION

An error has been identified in the map legend for the Summer Travel Map 5 for the Little Belt, Castle, and North Half Crazy Mountains travel management decision. The map legend erroneously shows that unlicensed ATVs and unlicensed trail bikes would be allowed on primary Forest Development roads coded as 20. The legend should read as follows:

Correction on SUMMER TRAVEL – MAP 5 legend highlighted in yellow:

Purpose of correction: Roads with a management code 20 have no restrictions to travel by **street legal** vehicles, which include street legal ATVs and trail bikes. Code 20 roads are generally primary access roads with a larger volume of traffic and higher speed traffic. It is our intent to continue to impose yearlong restrictions on unlicensed OHVs on roads with a code 20.
