**Non-Motorized Trail
Restriction Information**

**Based on the Birch Creek South
Travel Plan Decision, Oct. 2007**

The non-motorized trails listed in the table to the left are closed to bicycle use. There are also four designated hiker trails closed to both stock and bicycle use. See the accompanying map for visual reference to these restricted trail segments.

Other non-wilderness trails not listed in the table are open to all forms of summer non-motorized travel. All trails on the Forest are open to hikers. Wilderness trails are only open to non-mechanized forms of travel, including hiking and stock. Wilderness trails are closed to bicycles and any other wheeled or mechanized vehicles or carts, as well as to motorized uses.

Bicycle is defined as a vehicle with two in-line wheels, handlebars for steering, and a seat on which to sit, and pedals by which it is propelled by non-motorized means. Stock animals include any animals used for packing goods or carrying people.
