DEFINITIONS OF INDUSTRIES.

RETAIL TRADE (NAICS code 44-45).

Includes motor vehicle and parts dealers, motorcycle and ATV dealers, gasoline stations, sporting goods stores, general merchandise stores, convenience stores, grocery stores, clothing & shoe stores, jewelry and cosmetic stores, hardware and lumber stores, and all types of businesses that sell products at retail directly to the consumer.

ARTS, ENTERTAINMENT, RECREATION (NAICS code 71).

Includes amusement parks, arcades, casinos, golf courses, ski areas, bowling centers, marinas, fitness centers, archery ranges, and all types of outfitter/guide services.

ACCOMODATIONS & FOOD SERVICES (NAICS code 72).

Includes hotels, motels, RV parks and campgrounds, restaurants, bars, and caterers.

WHOLESALE TRADE (NAICS code 42).

Includes motor vehicle and parts distributors, motorcycle and ATV distributors, gasoline distributors, electrical/plumbing/lumber suppliers, grocery distributors, clothing and shoe suppliers, and all types of businesses that sell products in larger quantities at wholesale prices to retail stores.

PROFESSIONAL, SCIENTIFIC, TECHNICAL SERVICES (NAICS code 54).

Includes lawyers, legal services, accountants, architects, engineers, designers, computer system specialists, surveyors, advertising services, public relations specialists, veterinarians, and similar professional services.

HEALTH CARE AND SOCIAL ASSISTANCE (NAICS code 62).

Includes dentists, doctors, nurses, elder care, childcare, and all types of social services.
