


Camp




The Nez Perce National Forest will highlight the Civilian Conservation Corp (CCC) during Idaho Archaeology Month. A display will illustrate the ten CCC camps located on the Forest in the 1930's. The CCC boys provided the much needed labor to build ranger stations, lookouts, roads, trails, and bridges. The display will illustrate the camps, work performed, and the people involved in the implementation of President Franklin D. Roosevelt's 1933 "New Deal" program.
