

**SPECIAL AREA RESTRICTION  
Nez Perce National Forest  
ORDER**

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) 261.50(a) and 36 CFR 261.53(f) the following acts are prohibited on portions of the Red River Ranger District, as described in this order and shown on the attached map, within the Nez Perce National Forest. These restrictions are in addition to those general prohibitions in Title 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A, become effective immediately, and remain in effect until rescinded.

1. Going into or being on National Forest System lands, roads, or trails within the defined area below with a motorized vehicle [36 CFR 261.53(a) and 36 CFR 261.53(f)].

**LOCATION**

Beginning at the intersection of Forest Road #468 and Forest Trail #505 (SE¼ Sect. 5, T27N, R10E); then traveling easterly along Forest Road #468 to the junction with Forest Road #285 (SE¼ Sect. 28, T28N, R11E); then traveling in a northerly direction along Forest Road #285 to the junction with Forest Trail #647 (NW¼ Sect. 30, T29, R12E); then northwesterly along Forest Trail #647 to Granite Peak; then in a straight line westerly to the end of Forest Trail #615 (NW¼ Sect. 17, T29N, R11E); then southwestly along Forest Trail #615 to the junction with Forest Trail #668 (SW¼ Sect. 19, T29N, R11E); then south on Forest Trail #668 to the junction with Forest Trail #505 (NE¼ Sect. 36, T29N, R10E); then southeasterly on Forest Trail #505 to the point of beginning.

Roads and trails delineating the boundary of the area are open to motorized travel.

Roads #468 and #285 are open to highway vehicles.

Trails #615, #668, and #647 are open to motorcycles.

Trail #505 is open to vehicles less than 50" in width.

Green Mountain Lookout Road #285A is open to highway vehicles.

Snowmobiles over snow will be allowed.

Trails and roads within the area closure are closed to all motorized uses.

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt:

1. Persons with specific written authorization for the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

**RATIONALE:** These restrictions are promulgated for resource protection and protection of Endangered Species habitat.

**PENALTY:** Violations of these prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C 3559 and 3571)

**NOTIFICATION:** A copy of this order shall be posted in the Forest Supervisor's Office and each District Ranger's office and other appropriate locations as prescribed under Title 36 CFR 261.51.
