


# Motorized/Non-motorized use on the Kenai Peninsula



- ### Highlights
- Motorized access from Cooper Landing to Moose Pass.
  - Motorized access from Cooper Landing and Moose Pass to the Sterling Y and Summit Lake.
  - 21% of the Kenai designated for nonmotorized use (original plan allowed for 11%).
    - 41 miles of trail for non-motorized use.
  - 61% of the Kenai designated for motorized use (original plan allowed for 72%).
    - 120 miles of trail for motorized use.
  - 18% Season A/Season B-motorized/non-motorized. Generally between December 1st—April 30th. (previously 17% under a December 1 – February 15th season).
  - \* Trail River Campground non-motorized except for authorized motorized grooming.
