0029063-032	<p>Alternatives E and F: The NPS supports forest lands adjacent to KEFJ being zoned as wilderness as proposed under Alternatives E and F. Category prescriptions would complement NPS management of the boundary area. Specific concerns related to potential impacts on KEFJ park resources and visitor experiences that might be allowed under less restrictive prescriptions in other alternatives include</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Logging beetle killed trees/new or temporary roads/helicopter use along roads and river corridors</li><li>2. Prescribed or natural fire-suppression tactics/smoke management ~</li><li>3. Viewshed from park, logging clearcutting burn scars :7</li><li>4. Helicopter corridors for heli-skiing operations; and</li><li>5. Motorized use away from roads or trails (winter &amp; summer)</li></ol>
