0022865-002	Areas in Prince William Sound such as Knight and Montague Islands, Jack and Sawmill Bays need help for the wildlife to recover from the Exxon Valdez oil spill.
0026661-008	Glacier Ranger District: Protect the kittiwake seabird colony directly across from Whittier; too many boats too close, too long will have detrimental impacts on this important seabird nesting and feeding site. Do not permit day-use facilities; the boat traffic alone is more than enough stress, and that is inevitably going to increase.
0026961-002	The movement of large scale and faster tourism boats have substantially reduced the numbers of wildlife and seabirds in Prince William Sound. Protecting these areas and enforcing or regulating use would be a boost to the wildlife as it tries to recover from the effects of the devastation of the oil spill and the clear-cutting of hill sides
0027575-002	Additionally, Northern Montague Island from Zaikof to Port Chalmers should be designated a Western Hemisphere Shorebird Reserve because of its importance to the world's population of surfbirds (<i>Aphriza virgata</i>) and black turnstones (<i>Arenaria melanocephala</i>)
0034789-003	More site specifically, protect the kittiwake rookery near Whittier by making day use facilities conditional rather than permitted,
