- 0025-001 Protection, public education and interpretation of historic/cultural resources, including prehistoric archeology. We need a plan to survey the Forest for its cultural resources. This is a critical problem because many primary camping areas are on archeological sites!
- 0077-002 in the "Recreation and Tourism" category, I think that the forest has-made far too little of an effort to inventory and evaluate its cultural resources--and specifically its historical resources. As you well know, an invaluable historic log cabin was demolished near Moose Pass recently, and I would like to not see a repeat of this action in the foreseeable future. I would urge the USFS to commit extra \$ and/or personnel toward this effort, and not just as it pertains to compliance actions. There's a lot of history on your forest, and you need to pay more attention to it.
