Sample Activities:

Flora Factories: Plant ID, spruce-tip jelly, medicinal plants, paper-making, tree-coring, plant pressing, forestry, invasive plants, etc.

Into the Woods: Wilderness ethics, survival techniques, fire starting and safety, shelter building, map and compass, GPS, etc.

Fur and Feathers: Raptors, owl pellets, bird ID, mammal tracking, skulls and hides, track casting, bird banding, radio telemetry, etc.

Minerals Rock: Mineral testing, gold panning, glaciers, topographic models, garnet hunting, crystals, karst, etc.

Art in Nature: Digital photography, sketching, watercolors, clay sculptures, natural dyes and paints, etc.

Water Wonders: Water quality testing, watersheds, insects, fish, amphibians, radio telemetry, sockeye salmon tagging, fishing, etc.

Bring Back the Past: Archeology mapping, map and compass, fish traps, petroglyphs and pictographs, stratigraphy, etc.

Outdoor Adventures - Recreation in your National Forest: Overnight campout, hiking, boating safety, fire safety, geocaching, biking, outdoor cooking, fishing, etc.
