The US Forest Service Sitka Ranger District, beginning immediately and ending September 7, is prohibiting all dog access within one-quarter mile of the Redoubt Lake Falls Area, located 12 miles south of Sitka, Alaska. To date, eight different bears, including two sows with cubs, have been sighted in the vicinity of the falls. The additional presence of uncontrolled dogs brought by subsistence fishers has placed the Forest Service weir crew, as well as anglers and their pets, at serious risk of a major bear incident.
