### **PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD REGARDING CHANGES IN MOUNTAIN GOAT HUNTING IN UNIT 4 (Baranof Island)**

SITKA, Alaska—The Sitka District Ranger, under the authority granted by the Federal Subsistence Board, will hold a public hearing on Friday, July 15, 2011 starting at 6:30 p.m. This hearing will provide an opportunity for members of the public to offer comments on a special action request to make several changes to the mountain goat hunt on Baranof Island in Unit 4. The proposed special action would institute several smaller hunt areas on Baranof Island with separate harvest quotas for male and female goats for each hunt area and close three watersheds near Sitka to the harvest of mountain goat for conservation reasons.

The hearing will be held at Harrigan Centennial Hall, 330 Harbor Drive, Sitka, Alaska. You may call in to the hearing by dialing 1-866-406-5489.
