Ward Lake Bridge Approaches Construction

Ketchikan, AK – Reconstruction of the trail as it approaches the inlet to Ward Lake is scheduled to begin the week of August 27, 2012. The project will remove deteriorating stairs at either end of the bridge and install accessible boardwalk ramps and rails. Detours will be provided around the bridge for foot traffic. Construction is expected to be completed by October 15. Funding is provided by the U.S. Forest Service through the Resource Advisory Committee. The Contractor is P.K. Construction of Ketchikan, AK.
