



2. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire, except in designated campground and designated dispersed sites. 36 CFR 261.52(a)
 3. Camping except in designated campgrounds and designated dispersed campsites. 36 CFR 261.58(e)
 4. Discharging a firearm, air rifle or gas gun except persons legally hunting turkeys, waterfowl, small game or big game animals and persons discharging paintball guns. 36 CFR 261.58(m)
 6. Possessing a dog or transporting a dog. 36 CFR 261.58(s)
 7. Going into or being on the National Grassland within the restricted area shown on the map. 36 CFR 261.53(a)
 9. Possessing or using a mountain bike or motorized vehicle in the area shown on the map. 36 CFR 261.56
- * Closed to entry March 1 through June 30
 # No camping or fires within 200 feet of windmills, trailhead and overlook as shown on the map.

36 CFR 261.10(d) Prohibits the discharge of firearms or any other implement capable of taking human life, causing serious injury or damaging property as follows: (1) In or within 150 yards of any residence, building, campsite or occupied area, or (2) Across or on any road or body of water adjacent thereto, or in any manner or place whereby any person or property is exposed to damage as a result in such discharge.
