67 CHIEF OF PARTY / FLIGHT MANAGER (Refer to the NMG 67)

The Chief of Party / Flight Manager is supervised by the sending unit dispatcher until destination is reached. Chief of Party is responsible for all personnel assigned on the manifest list. The Chief of Party / Flight Manager duties are:

1. To explain to all personnel at the beginning of travel, transportation arrangements, type of equipment, route of travel, stopping points, ETAs, etc.
2. To have copies of manifests covering all personnel assigned, extra copies available for charter aircraft and submission to receiving camps, etc., from sending dispatcher.
3. To ensure proper flight following procedures are met.
4. To have the telephone numbers of the sending and receiving dispatcher's offices for use when delays of more than 30 minutes occur, to give information as to why and how long the delay will be.
5. Have all personnel within the weight limitations, assembled, and ready to board.
6. Provide for the safety and welfare of each person assigned to the manifest list.
7. Check pilot card and aircraft data card for currency and qualifications.
8. Chief of Party / Flight Manager has total responsibility for insuring that all passengers arrive at their destination.
9. Chief of Party / Flight Manager will be responsible for signing the Daily Flight Report - Invoices (Form 6500-122 or OAS-23) for all flights (except for domestic air carriers, airlines and NIFC contract aircraft).
10. Ensure all personnel have a copy of their resource order with request number and position assigned.

“Incident Management Teams ordered through NICC, regardless of Type, will be either a long or short team configuration as defined by the NMG 68.2 in terms of staffing numbers. The RMCG has approved the following variation of the standard IMT configuration. Incident Commanders are authorized to negotiate additional positions with the requesting unit. The Deputy Incident Commander position is optional for either a short or long team configuration. The following positions will only be filled by current agency employees on the National IMT and Area Type 2 IMTs: Incident Commander, Deputy Incident Commander, Finance Section Chief, Procurement Unit Leader, Compensation/Claims Unit Leader, and Compensation Specialist.”

Unless notified otherwise, the identified trainees will be mobilized for all incidents. The National Type 1 IMT rotation is maintained throughout the calendar year.

For Type 2 IMT national assignments trainees will be negotiated with the ordering unit.

Rocky Mountain and Great Basin (Rocky Basin) Type 1 Incident Management Teams have joined together for inter-area utilization and National rotation. This means a total of 3 Type 1 Overhead Teams in the Rocky Basin. RMA hosts one of those.

The Rocky Mountain Area has 2 Type 2 Overhead Teams.

RMA IMT's will be dispatched in the Long Team Configuration, unless otherwise specified by the requesting unit.

The RMA Type 2 IMT's will be on-call in a long team configuration.

69.7 NATIONAL PARK SERVICE FIRE USE MODULES

(Refer to NMG 69.8)

The RMA has two Fire Use Modules. The Black Hills Module (NPS) is located in South Dakota and is dispatched by Northern Great Plains Dispatch Center. The Unawep Fire Use Module (BLM) is located in Grand Junction Colorado and is dispatched by the Grand Junction Air Center.

The core module for mobilization will be a minimum of leader plus three. Typically, dispatch is leader plus six but is at the requestors discretion to specify exactly what they need. For FS modules, the current configuration is leader plus nine.
