


Grand Mesa National Forest Christmas Tree & Winter Travel Map

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AREAS CLOSED TO CHRISTMAS TREE CUTTING

- Grand Valley Ranger District: National Forest Open to Tree Cutting
- Private Lands Within Forest Boundary: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting
- Grand Mesa Visitor Center: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting
- Campgrounds: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting
- Lodges: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting
- Highway 65: Closed to Tree Cutting within 100' of Roadway
- "G" Areas: Closed to Tree Cutting - Timber Sales
- "F" Areas: Closed to Tree Cutting - Designated Nordic Ski Areas
- "D" Areas: Closed to Tree Cutting - Powderhorn Ski Area

WINTER "OVER-THE-SNOW" TRAVEL REGULATIONS

- National Forest: Open to Snowmobile Travel with 6" Snow Depth
- Private Lands Within Forest Boundaries
- Cross-Country Ski Trails: Closed to Motorized Travel
- Snowmobile Trail: Open to Snowmobile Travel with 6" Snow Depth
- "A" Areas: Closed to Motorized Travel - Winter Range Closure (11/15 - 5/1)
- "B" Areas: Restricted Motorized Travel (Designated Routes) - Spring Calving Closure (4/15 - 5/15)
- "D" Areas: Closed to Motorized Travel - Powderhorn Ski Area
- "E" Areas: Recommend Motorized Travel on Designated Routes - Backcountry Nordic Area
- "F" Areas: Closed to Motorized Travel - Designated Nordic Ski Areas

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
