


# Uncompahgre National Forest Christmas Tree and Winter Travel Map

Winter Motorized Travel Regulations Apply  
December 1st - April 15th



### Areas Closed to Tree Cutting

- Grand Valley Ranger District: National Forest Open to Tree Cutting
- Campgrounds: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting
- Ranger Station: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting
- Picnic Ground: Areas Closed to Tree Cutting

### Winter "Over-Snow" Travel Regulations

- Road - Light Duty, Gravel
- Road - Light Duty, Dirt
- Road - Unimproved
- Administrative Routes - Authorized Use Only
- Forest Designated Trail
- Designated Route Within Seasonal Closure
- Private Lands within National Forest
- "S" Areas: Closed to Motorized Travel, Except on Designated Routes (Green)

### Travel Hierarchy

The travel map displays route designations based on a travel hierarchy. Routes designated open to a specific use are also open to all uses identified below that use. However, that route is not designated as open to any of the uses shown above.

Cross-country travel by over-snow vehicles is permitted over at least six inches of snow, in many areas. Specific areas are closed to over-snow vehicles as indicated on the map with "S", prohibits motor vehicle use for the protection of sensitive wildlife from December 1st - April 15th.

During these dates, these restrictions apply to all motor vehicle use. Specific routes for are identified (green) for motorized travel through these seasonal travel restricted areas. Additionally, all wheeled travel vehicles are subject to remaining on designated routes which are displayed as roads or ATV trails on this map.

Penalties for Travel Violations may include up to \$5,000 in fines, 6 months in jail and restitution for any resource damages incurred.
