**Opportunity to Comment on South Prong Hayden Creek Travel Management Project**

The U.S. Forest Service proposes to extend the single-track motorized designation for the Rainbow Trail approximately 0.6 miles from its crossing of South Prong Hayden Creek (Freemont County, CO) to its intersection with FSR 006. The project is located in T 47 N, R 10 E, sec. 13, 14 and 23. A draft memorandum detailing the proposal is available for review at the Salida Ranger District. **How to Comment and Timeframe**

Written, facsimile, hand-delivered, oral, and electronic comments concerning this action will be accepted for 30 calendar days following publication of this notice in the Mountain Mail. The publication date in the newspaper of record is the exclusive means for calculating the comment period for this proposal. Those wishing to comment should not rely upon dates or timeframe information provided by any other source. The regulations prohibit extending the length of the comment period.

Written comments must be submitted to: Bill Schuckert, District Ranger, Salida Ranger District, 325 W. Rainbow Blvd, Salida, CO 81201. The office business hours for those submitting hand-delivered comments are: 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM Monday through Friday, excluding holidays.

Oral comments must be provided at the Responsible Official's office during normal business hours via telephone 719-539-3591 or in person, or at an official agency function (i.e. public meeting) that is designed to elicit public comments. Electronic comments must be submitted in a format such as an email message, plain text (.txt), rich text format (.rtf), or Word (.doc) to [phillipgaines@fs.fed.us](mailto:phillipgaines@fs.fed.us). In cases where no identifiable name is attached to a comment, a verification of identity will be required for appeal eligibility. If using an electronic message, a scanned signature is one way to provide verification.

It is the responsibility of persons providing comments to submit them by the close of the comment period. Individuals and organizations wishing to be eligible to appeal must meet the information requirements of 36 CFR 215.6.
