

**MANAGEMENT AREAS**

Management areas are groupings of capability areas which will be managed with a particular emphasis through application of a specific combination of multiple-use objectives. The management emphasis on the area in which an emphasis applies may vary between alternatives.

**1b-1** MANAGEMENT AREA 1b-1 - Provides for winter water sports sites, recreation opportunities from downhill skiing during the winter and an organized recreation during the rest of the year. Snow machine skiing may occur.

**1b-2** MANAGEMENT AREA 1b-2 - Provides for potential winter sports sites, as mentioned for future ski areas, and other recreation opportunities. The area is a natural appearing forest with subtle vegetation changes. Recreation opportunities focus on dispersed recreation uses.

**2a** MANAGEMENT AREA 2a - Management emphasis is for major oil and gas pipelines, water, water transportation and other pipelines, electrical transmission lines, and telecommunication lines. Activities within these corridors and sites will be compatible with the adjacent management area direction.

**2b** MANAGEMENT AREA 2b - Management emphasis is for multipurpose recreational opportunities, such as snowmobiling, four-wheel driving, and motorcycling, both on and off roads and trails. Range recreation provides sustained forage yield.

**3a** MANAGEMENT AREA 3a - Provides opportunity for nonmotorized recreation in a nonwilderness semiprimitive setting.

**4b** MANAGEMENT AREA 4b - Provides wildlife habitat needs and provide dispersed authorized and nonauthorized recreation and sustained forage yield.

**4d** MANAGEMENT AREA 4d - Management emphasis is on maintaining and improving riparian areas. Riparian areas are managed to produce excellent habitat, wood products, visual quality and plant and animal diversity.

**5b** MANAGEMENT AREA 5b - Emphasizes the management of forage and cover on the game water system.

**6b** MANAGEMENT AREA 6b - Emphasizes management for livestock grazing. Intensive grazing management systems are favored over extensive systems.

**7a** MANAGEMENT AREA 7a - Emphasizes productive tree stand management on lands available to timber and suitable for production of a variety of commercial and noncommercial wood products.

**7b** MANAGEMENT AREA 7b - Management emphasis is on production and utilization of small roundwood of a size and quality suitable for products such as furniture, posts, poles, and pulp.

**8b** MANAGEMENT AREA 8b - Provides for a primitive recreation opportunity in areas of low use and especially unimproved natural wilderness within Congressionally designated and proposed wilderness.

**8c** MANAGEMENT AREA 8c - Provides for a multipurpose recreation opportunity in areas of moderate to low use within Congressionally designated and proposed wilderness.

**9a** MANAGEMENT AREA 9a - Riparian area management. Resource use will be managed to protect and enhance the riparian area. Management treatments will enhance plant and animal diversity. Primitive, semiprimitive, nonmotorized, semiprimitive, motorized, and special interest and special recreation opportunities can be provided.

**9b** Only those 9a management areas which are practical to portray on this map are shown. This provision actually applies to all riparian areas located anywhere on the Forest, except those in Wilderness, Research National Areas, and Special Interest Areas.

**10a** MANAGEMENT AREA 10a - Provides for the management of existing and potential Research National Areas.
