

# Circle T Cabin



**T**he Circle T Cabin is the first hut in the developing Turkey Springs Hut and Trail System available for rent to visitors of the San Juan National Forest. The cabin is shaded by large ponderosa pines and situated adjacent to a large meadow and the historic Turkey Springs Guard Station. The Turkey Springs area provides opportunities for mountain biking, cross-country skiing, and snow-mobiling, depending on season and snow cover.



## Amenities

This modern but rustic cabin is handicapped accessible and equipped with propane lantern, heat, and cooking stove. The one-room cabin sleeps 3 people with one set of bunk beds and one single bed. Additional visitors can be accommodated by bringing their own pads for sleeping in the loft. Maximum occupancy is 8. The cabin is stocked with eating and cooking equipment, table, and chairs. There is an outdoor toilet. A complete list of furnishings is supplied with the rental agreement. Horse pasture is not available.

## Water

There is no water at this site; be prepared to bring your own.

## Fees

The fee is \$50 per night, and maximum occupancy is 8 people. There is no refund of fees if cancellation occurs within 2 weeks prior to the reservation date.

## Reservations

The cabin may be reserved up to three months in advance of the reservation date, with payment of fees required two weeks in advance of the reserved date. To reserve your time at the Circle T Cabin please call (970) 264-2268. You will need to provide the desired arrival and departure dates and number of people per night. Occupancy is from 2 P.M. to noon.

## No Maid Service

Visitors are responsible for keeping and leaving the cabin clean.

## Location

The cabin is about 10.5 miles by road northwest of Pagosa Springs. From Hwy. 160, turn north on Piedra Road. Travel about 6 miles to the end of the pavement, continue on the gravel road about 1/2 mile, then turn left (west) on Turkey Springs Road (#629) and travel 3 miles. Turn right at sign for Guard Station. From this point it is about 1 mile to the cabin. Stay left at the "Y". Depending on weather and use, the last 1/2 mile of road to the cabin may be rough. In winter, access to the cabin may be by snowmobile, foot, snowshoes, or cross-country skis for up to 4 miles. See map on reverse side.
